REGISTRATION FEE: \$30 per boat (add \$5 in not a member of US Sailing). Fee includes Continental Breakfast and Cocktail Party/Dinner. Fee does not include lunch. PYC Deli Service available.

1. RULES

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. All US SAILING Prescriptions shall apply. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration Saturday morning and will require a Protest Flag be displayed as a Protest Requirement. (This modifies RR 61.1(a) (2).) State law requires a USCG approved PFD for each person on board, and a throwable cushion.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Regatta is open to all Interlake sailors. Enter by completing the Entry Form and submitting it along with the required fee as provided on the entry form.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on Saturday morning.

5. VENUE

5. Portage Yacht Club, on Portage Lake, is 14 mile northwest of Ann Arbor at 8900 Dexter-Pinckney Rd. Pinckney, Michigan 48169. A beautiful clubhouse provides an excellent view of the clear, glacier lake, and offers excellent dining and modern facilities. On-site launching and mooring sites are available. See www.ms-pyc.com for information on the Club and a map.

6. THE COURSES

6.1 The races will be sailed around moveable buoys set in triangular and/or windward-leeward configurations.

7. SCORING

7.1 Low-Point Scoring of Appendix A shall apply except that a boat's series will be the total of her race scores, and first place finishes shall be scored as 0.75 points (This modifies rule A4).

7.2 One race will constitute a series.

7.3 Prizes will be awarded for the first three finishes. Special prizes may also be awarded.

8. FAMILY AND SPECTATORS

8.1 Family and guests of competitors are welcome to attend and use the Portage Yacht Club facilities during the regatta, including showers as well as the upper deck, which provides an excellent view of the racing area.

BOAT LAUNCHING. Tilt trailers are recommended. For non-tilt trailers and/or boats with full boat covers, a boat hoist and a tilt trailer can be provided to facilitate launching.
